## **Budget Basics**

- The District's budget is unique. It acts like a state, county, city and school district budget all in one.
- The District's fiscal year is October 1 September 30
- Our budget has two parts:
  - Operating budget programs and services
    - \$8 billion local funds
    - \$3 billion Federal grants and Medicaid
  - \$1 billion Capital budget infrastructure
