

WHAT'S PROPOSED IN THIS YEAR'S BUDGET

HOUSING & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- **\$515 million** for the Chinatown Revitalization Fund to support sports arena renovations, streetscape improvements, public space activations, and/or expanded green space
- **\$10 million** to improve parks and roadways located within the Historic Green Triangle, including connecting Farragut Square and McPherson Square via a green boulevard
- **\$5 million** to create a new Downtown Arts Hub to bring theatre, dance, music, and visual arts organizations downtown

LEARNING & RECREATION

- **\$194 million** to modernize and renovate public schools, including the new Center City MS and Seaton ES
- **\$886,000** for mechanical and other upgrades at the Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Library

TRANSPORTATION & ENVIRONMENT

- \$406 million to maintain streets, sidewalks, and alleys citywide
- **\$164 million** citywide for interventions to improve pedestrian and bicycle safety, including making temporary safety installations permanent and installing new safety infrastructure near schools
- \$27 million for bus priority improvements on 18 segments, including 7th Street NW/SW, 14th Street NW/SW, and Connecticut Avenue NW
- \$1 million for a comprehensive Downtown transportation vision
