## NEW INVESTMENTS FOR FY 2020



### RESPONSIVE POLICE FORCE

**\$3M**

Expanding MPD officers to 4,000 by 2021, focusing on bikes and on-foot officers



### VIOLENCE INTERRUPTERS

**\$714K**

Expanding participation in the Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (ONSE)



### EMPLOYMENT PATHWAYS

**\$610K**

Increasing wages for the Pathways program participants and expand the Aspire to Entrepreneurship Program

## PROMISES KEPT



Opened ONSE and opened the Pathways program - bringing 10 weeks of classes, therapy, and life-skills training to District residents



Over the past two years, tripled the size of the MPD cadet program



Installed more than 13,000 security cameras through the Private Security Camera Incentive Program



Opened the READY Center to connect formerly incarcerated residents with critical post-release services, such as housing and employment assistance
