INVESTMENTS IN HOUSING & ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

- **\$24M** to continue work at Park Morton & **\$25M** for Bruce Monroe
- **\$1.6M** to renovate affordable senior housing at Harvard Towers



INVESTMENTS IN EDUCATION & COMMUNITIES

- **\$110M** to turn the old Banneker school into the new Center City Middle School
- **\$67M** for the modernization of Adams Education Campus
- **\$7.9M** to add the modernization of Bruce Monroe @ Parkview Elementary to the CIP
- **\$99.4M** for the modernization of Tubman Elementary
- **\$750K** to renovate the splash pad at 14th and Park NW



INVESTMENTS IN TRANSPORTATION & ENVIRONMENT

- **\$23.5M** to continue historic investment in bringing Ward 1 streets into a state of good repair
- **\$112M** to rehabilitate, reconstruct, and maintain sidewalks citywide
- **\$100M** to bring alleys into a state of good repair through maintenance and reconstruction
- **\$13M** for the reconstruction of U Street NW between 14th and 18th Streets to make the corridor safer and more inviting for pedestrians and bicyclists
- **\$26M** for eight Bus Priority projects citywide in FY24, including three projects in Ward 1: Columbia Road NW (16th St. to California Ave. NW), Georgia Ave. (Barry Pl. to Kansas Ave. NW), and 14th Street (Newton Street to Upshur Street NW)
