

MAYOR MURIEL BOWSER'S FY 2024-FY 2029 Proposed Capital Investments



INVESTMENTS IN HOUSING & ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

- **\$1.7M** to fund upgrades and renovations for senior and disabled residents at Horizon House



INVESTMENTS IN EDUCATION & COMMUNITIES

- **\$55M** to complete the renovation of Francis/Stevens School Without Walls to include a new full-sized gymnasium and three new special education classrooms
- **\$83.7M** for the modernization of Seaton Elementary
- **\$3.3M** to renovate the cafeteria at Hardy Middle School
- **\$9.8M** for the creation of a new Farragut Square Park downtown, similar to the renovation of Franklin Square
- **\$400K** for improvements to Book Hill Park in Georgetown
- **\$2.2M** for a new athletic field and playground equipment at Thomson Elementary



INVESTMENTS IN TRANSPORTATION & ENVIRONMENT

- **\$23.5M** to continue historic investment in bringing Ward 2 streets into a state of good repair
- **\$26M** for eight Bus Priority projects citywide in FY24, including two projects in Ward 2: 13th Street NW (K Street to Pennsylvania Ave.), and 7th Street NW (Massachusetts Ave. to Pennsylvania Ave.)
- **\$12M** for the reconstruction of U Street NW between 14th and 18th Streets to make the corridor safer and more inviting for pedestrians and bicyclists
- **\$36M** to complete the Pennsylvania Ave. NW streetscape between 17th St. NW and Washington Circle
- **\$3M** for Georgetown (Wisconsin Ave. NW) Safety and Mobility project
- **\$4M** for Black Lives Matter Plaza Phase 2
