INVESTMENTS IN HOUSING & ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

- **\$24M** to continue development at Northwest One as part of the New Communities Initiative
- **\$5M** to repair the Fish Market Piers at the Wharf
- **\$7.4M** for renovations to the DC General campus, including electrical power upgrades
- **\$7M** in FY 2023 supplemental funding for the construction of the Blair Men's Shelter



INVESTMENTS IN EDUCATION & COMMUNITIES

- **\$91M** for the renovation of J.O. Wilson Elementary School
- **\$94M** for the renovation of Brent Elementary School
- **\$90M** for the renovation of Tyler Elementary School
- **\$84M** for the renovation of Amidon-Bowen Elementary School
- **\$9.5M** for Ludlow-Taylor Elementary expansion
- **\$1.5M** to modernize the Peabody Playground
- **\$25M** for the renovation of Northwest Library
- **\$10M** additional funding to support the renovation of Southeast Library
- **\$17M** for the renovation of Randall Recreation Center
- **\$12M** for the renovation of Rumsey Aquatic Center
- **\$1M** for the expansion of RH Terrell Recreation Center
- **\$6.8M** for the renovation of Rosedale Pool
- **\$15M** towards the renovation of the Old Miner building
- **\$4M** for renovations at the Sherwood Recreation Center
- **\$1.5M** for the replacement of the roof at King-Greenleaf Recreation Center
- **\$750K** to renovate the splash pad at Watkins Recreation Center

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INVESTMENTS IN TRANSPORTATION & ENVIRONMENT

- **\$23.5M** to continue historic investment in bringing Ward 6 streets into a state of good repair
- **\$112M** to rehabilitate, reconstruct, and maintain sidewalks citywide
- **\$100M** to bring alleys into a state of good repair through maintenance and reconstruction
- **\$220M** to replace the aging H Street Bridge behind Union Station to address safety concerns, support redevelopment, and enable the expansion of high-speed rail
- **\$211M** for Benning Road Streetscape, Bridges Reconstruction, and Streetcar work
- **\$26M** for eight Bus Priority projects citywide in FY24, including one project in Ward 6: H Street NE (North Capitol Street to Benning Road NE)
- **\$20M** for the Anacostia Riverwalk Neighborhood Access trail work, west of the river, from 11th Street SE to Pennsylvania Avenue SE
- **\$24M** to Pennsylvania Avenue SE and Potomac Avenue SE intersection improvements



INVESTMENTS IN HEALTH & PUBLIC SAFETY

- **\$7M** in FY 2023 to relocate DOC's Central Cell Block out of the Daly Building
