## INVESTMENTS IN HOUSING & ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

- **\$66M** for development at Barry Farm as part of New Communities
- **\$12M** to lay the groundwork for future development at Poplar Point
- **\$22M** to renovate affordable family housing at Highland Addition



## INVESTMENTS IN EDUCATION & COMMUNITIES

- **\$24M** to complete the renovation of Garfield Elementary School
- **\$61M** for the renovation of Green Elementary School
- **\$65M** for the renovation of King Elementary School
- **\$78M** for the renovation of Ketcham Elementary School
- **\$52M** to begin the renovation of Simon Elementary School
- **\$53M** to begin the renovation of Hendley Elementary School
- **\$22M** for the renovation of Parkland Turner Community Campus
- **\$119M** for the Hart Middle School modernization
- **\$12M** for the renovation of Excel Academy
- **\$24M** to replace modular capacity with permanent capacity at Leckie Elementary School
- **\$33M** for the renovation of Bard Early College
- **\$24M** for the renovation of Douglas Recreation Center
- **\$4M** to renovate the Fort Greble Recreation Center
- **\$5.6M** in FY 2023 supplemental funding for the Southeast Tennis and Learning Center
- **\$3.6M** for a refresh of the Anacostia Library
- **\$3M** to renovate the HVAC system at the Barry Farm Recreation Center

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## INVESTMENTS IN TRANSPORTATION & ENVIRONMENT

- **\$23.5M** to continue historic investment in bringing Ward 8 streets into a state of good repair
- **\$112M** to rehabilitate, reconstruct, and maintain sidewalks citywide
- **\$100M** to bring alleys into a state of good repair through maintenance and reconstruction
- **\$47M** for construction of the 11<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge Park
- **\$27M** to rehabilitate the Suitland Parkway pedestrian and bicycle trail
- **\$47M** to build the Shepherd Branch Trail
- **\$3M** for Phase 2 of the Oxon Run Trail
- **\$61M** for streetscapes and safety improvements along four miles of Alabama Ave. SE to make it safer to walk and bike along the corridor
- **\$20M** for new pedestrian safety improvements along Wheeler Rd. SE, including curb extensions and other measures to improve pedestrian visibility and slow vehicles
- **\$3.3M** to begin planning and design work for the Southern Ave. (13<sup>th</sup> Street to 23<sup>rd</sup> Street SE) streetscape project
- **\$16M** to improve pedestrian and traffic safety along Martin Luther King Jr Blvd. SE and Good Hope Rd. SE
- **\$26M** for eight Bus Priority projects citywide in FY24, including one project in Ward 8: Minnesota Ave. SE (Good Hope Road SE to Pennsylvania Ave. SE)



## INVESTMENTS IN HEALTH & PUBLIC SAFETY

- **\$33M** to modernize MPD's 7th District headquarters
- **\$126M** to finish building the new Cedar Hill Regional Medical Center at St. Elizabeth's
- **\$55M** for roads, utilities, and other infrastructure on the St. Elizabeths campus
