INVESTMENTS IN HOUSING & ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

- **\$27M** to continue work at Park Morton & **\$25M** for Bruce Monroe



INVESTMENTS IN EDUCATION & COMMUNITIES

- **\$99M** for the renovation of Tubman Elementary School
- **\$110M** for a Center City Middle School at the old Banneker High School
- **\$64M** for the renovation of Adams Education Campus
- **\$12M** for the renovation of Park View Recreation Center
- **\$21M** for the renovation of the Rita Bright Family and Youth Center



INVESTMENTS IN TRANSPORTATION & ENVIRONMENT

- **\$23.5M** to continue historic investment in bringing Ward 1 streets into a state of good repair
- **\$114M** to rehabilitate, reconstruct, and maintain sidewalks citywide
- **\$102M** to bring alleys into a state of good repair through maintenance and reconstruction
- **\$12M** for the reconstruction of U Street NW between 14th and 18th Streets to make the corridor safer and more inviting for pedestrians and bicyclists
- **\$9.8M** to accelerate the S Street NW streetscape between 4th and 7th Streets to FY 2022



INVESTMENTS IN HEALTH & PUBLIC SAFETY

- **\$25M** for needed public infrastructure to support the new Shaw-Howard University Hospital
