## INVESTMENTS IN HOUSING & ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

- **\$10M** to finalize development at Children's National Hospital



## INVESTMENTS IN EDUCATION & COMMUNITIES

- **\$79M** for the renovation of Raymond Elementary School
- **\$58M** for the renovation of Dorothy Height Elementary School
- **\$23M** for the renovation of Barnard Elementary School
- **\$36M** for the renovation of LaSalle-Backus Elementary School
- **\$9.6M** to add a dedicated cafeteria at Coolidge High School
- **\$73M** for the renovation of Whittier Education Campus
- **\$15M** for the renovation of Upshur Recreation Center
- **\$13M** for the renovation of Emery Heights Recreation Center
- **\$25M** for a New 4A Library
- **\$1M** for minor renovations of Petworth Library



## INVESTMENTS IN TRANSPORTATION & ENVIRONMENT

- **\$23.5M** to continue historic investment in bringing Ward 4 streets into a state of good repair
- **\$114M** to rehabilitate, reconstruct, and maintain sidewalks citywide
- **\$102M** to bring alleys into a state of good repair through maintenance and reconstruction
- **\$7.9M** to complete the Metropolitan Branch Trail from Blair Rd. to Piney Branch Rd.
- **\$14.5M** to complete the Metropolitan Branch Trail from First Pl. to Oglethorpe St.
